# DIVINE MERCY DEVOTION MINISTRY

Part 1 S C C T

The second year of the novitiate was approaching. Whenever I recalled that I was to make my vows, my soul shuddered. I did not understand what I was reading; I could not meditate; it seemed to me that my prayer was displeasing to God. It seemed to me that by approaching the Holy Sacraments I was offending God

even more. But despite this, my confessor did not let me omit one single Holy Communion. God was working very strangely in my soul. I did not understand anything at all of what my confessor was telling me. The simple truths of the faith became incomprehensible to me. My soul was anguish, unable to find comfort anywhere. (23)

However, in all these sufferings and struggles, (Saint Faustina was undergoing intense spiritual trials) I was not omitting Holy Communion. When it seemed to me that I should not communicate, I went, before Holy Communion, to the Directress and told her that I could not approach the Sacrament, because it seemed to me that I should not do so. But she would not permit me to omit Holy Communion, so I went, and I understand now, that it was only obedience that saved me. The Directress told me later that my trials had passed quickly, "and this solely because you were obedient, Sister: and it was through the power of obedience that you struggled through this so bravely." It is true that it was the Lord himself who brought me out of this torment, but my fidelity to obedience did please him. (105)



Now is the time to prepare for the Roman Missal, Third Edition New Words: A Deeper Meaning, but the same Mass

The Roman Missal will be implemented in the United States of America on the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011.

What will make the changes in the Roman Missal meaningful to the Congregation?

With the implementation of the liturgical reform of the Second Vatican Council the use of sacred scripture was re-established in the celebration of the Church's liturgy. In the post-Second Vatican Council Lectionary for Mass, the Liturgy of the Hours, and the ritual books for the celebration of the Church's sacraments and sacramentals, the Church has nourished hearts and minds of people with a rich and diverse use of scripture.

The revised translation of the Roman Missal captures scriptural allusions more explicitly and clearly. Thus, the congregation will hear in the revised translation of the Eucharistic Prayer III the beautiful image from the words of the prophet Malachi, "you never cease to gather a people to yourself, so that from the rising of the sun to its setting a pure sacrifice may be offered to your name." The revised translation of the conclusion of the invitation to Communion, "Blessed are those called to the banquet of the Lamb," presents John's eschatological vision of the heavenly banquet in Revelation 19:9. In their response to this invitation, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof . . .," congregation will echo the words of the centurion in Luke 7:6-7.

In all other changes in the entire Revised Roman Missal, many of us will first find the prayers to be in a style and register more formal than the prayers we presently experience. In the course of time, however, as we come to constantly familiarize ourselves of the new translation the greater attention paid to reflecting the underlying scriptural imagery of the Latin text and the ingenious way the ancient author uses this imagery, we will benefit from a fuller translation of the rich tradition of the Church's origin and source of prayers.

Msgr. Campion, editor of **The Priest** and associate publisher of **Our Sunday Visitor** offers his own affirmative commentaries: "I like this new translation, because it so well furthers this association between the liturgy and the Bible. In a word, I look forward eagerly to learning more about the new translation and finally, as a celebrant, to using it."

# $\mathcal{L}$ ESUS, Our Example of $\mathbf{LOVE}$

The **First Reading** is the only full, detailed account of the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven (today's Gospel is a more perfunctory version). It is dedicated to Theophilus, *Theos* meaning God and *phileo* meaning love. Hence, it is dedicated to those who love God, i.e., all Christians. We are given an outline of Jesus' ministry before His crucifixion and after, including His live appearances to His apostles. *The promise of the gift of the Holy Spirit will be fulfilled on Pentecost.* Here, we see Him ascend into heaven on a cloud. In the Book

of Daniel, it is predicted that the Son of Man would *descend from heaven on a cloud,* so it is appropriate that He *ascend* in the same way. However, Heaven is not really up above, it is a different dimension, beyond our understanding. The image of ascending upward is used by Jesus to help them understand what has happened, He returned to His Father, from whence He came.

The **Responsorial**, **Psalm 47**, praises God as King of heaven and earth; on His throne where He ascended on Ascension day. He has been exalted and proclaimed as Lord of the universe. Every knee shall bend, every head bow at the mention of His name. By celebrating God as Lord and King, we commit ourselves to the project of living as if He were the Lord of our lives. We praise Him and celebrate His goodness; we observe His commands and live for and in Him. St. Francis of Assisi often said, "*My God and my all.*" This is exactly what it means to make Jesus King of our lives.

The **Second Reading** is a prayer to understand the profound nature of the mystery into which God calls us, our redemption. If we comprehend the glory of our call and what's in store for us, then we'll never abandon it. The key to this understanding is to reflect on this mystery of our redemption. Jesus died for us, but the Father exalted Him and welcomed Him into His glory through the Ascension. The Father also proclaimed Jesus as Lord of all creation. The Father considered Him most loving when Jesus was obedient unto death. We might consider this humiliation, but it was His hour of glory, and for this the Father exalts Him in supreme glory. Reflecting on this helps us realize that when we are obedient to the Father's will, we are not losing our dignity, but are living at the deepest level of love.

In today's **Gospel**, we find the final commission Jesus gives His apostles. There are five major points: **(1)** Jesus has all power and **(2)** He gives His authority to His disciples to **(3)** go make disciples of all nations through baptism in the Holy Trinity. **(4)** He promises to always be with us to guide and protect us, **(5)** until He returns in glory.


