Message from Deacon Rick Morales



On this **6th Sunday of Easter**, we continue our reading of the Gospel of John as we enter into the Last Supper Discourses. What we hear from Jesus in the **Gospel reading** today is in reply to a question asked of Jesus by one of the disciples. "Master, what happened that you will reveal yourself to us and not to the world?" This question was asked because Jesus had told the disciple that He wouldn't

be with them much longer. It was a commonly held belief of the Jews that when the Messiah came He would be revealed to the whole world as King and Savior. Jesus answers the question realizing that His disciples don't fully understand but will one day when the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in His name will teach them everything and remind them of what Jesus had told them.

In the **First reading** we are given a glimpse into the governing of the early Church and how the Holy Spirit that Jesus had spoken of in the Upper Room on Holy Thursday had indeed come and was active in the governance of the Church through the apostles. The event that we read about today was the occasion of the first Council of the Church, the Council of Jerusalem. This came about because instruction was being given by some who had come down from Judea to Antioch that was causing an unnecessary burden to those in the Church. As is related in the reading it was decided that Paul and Barnabas should go up to Jerusalem to speak with the apostles and elders about the issue. The decision that came down from the Church leadership states that "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us". From the earliest days of the Church its leadership knew that they had the authority to govern and were guided by the Holy Spirit in their work. This is still the case in our day. It is a great comfort to us to know that Christ didn't leave us orphaned but guides His Church by means of its leadership through the Holy Spirit.

In our **Second reading** from the Book of Revelation we hear of the heavenly Jerusalem. The temple is described as being a splendid structure. It is said to have a massive, high wall, with twelve gates where twelve angels were stationed and on which the names of the twelve tribes of Israel were inscribed. It is important to note that the foundation of this structure was made up of twelve courses of stones on which were inscribed the names of the twelve of apostles. This is meant to convey that there is a connection between the Chosen People of Israel and the Church that Jesus founded but that the foundation of the Church rests on the twelve Apostles. The three gates facing north, south, east and west indicate that the Church is universal, open to all, and that all nations must come to it to gain salvation.

The **Ascension of the Lord**, a holy day of obligation, celebrates the day that Christ, in the presence of His apostles, ascended bodily into heaven. The Ascension occurred 40 days after Easter Sunday, so it falls on Thursday, May 9th; however, in most dioceses in the United States, the celebration of the Ascension has been transferred to the following **Sunday, May 12th - the 7th Sunday of Easter.**

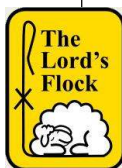

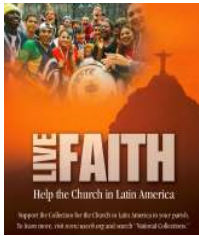

St. Catherine of Siena (1347-1380)
Prayer to Divine Mercy

O eternal Mercy, you who cover over your creatures' faults! By your mercy we were created. And by your mercy we were created anew in your Son's blood. It is your mercy that preserves us. Your mercy made your Son play death against life and life against death on the wood of the cross. In him life confounded the death that is our sin.

I see your mercy pressing you to give us even more when you leave yourself with us as food to strengthen our weakness, so that we forgetful fools should be reminded forever of your goodness.

Who was conquered? Death! And how? By your mercy! You temper your justice with mercy. In mercy you cleansed us in the blood; in mercy you kept company with your creatures.

O mad lover! It was not enough for you to take on our humanity, you had to die as well! Nor was death enough: you descended to the depths to summon our holy ancestors and fulfill your truth and mercy in them. I see your mercy pressing you to give us even more when you leave yourself with us as food to strengthen our weakness, so that we forgetful fools should be reminded forever of your goodness.

And what has done this? Your mercy. O mercy! My heart is engulfed with the thought of you! For wherever I turn my thoughts, I find nothing but mercy! (Dialogue 30).

Portable Restroom Project Update

The completion date for the portable restroom project has been moved to a later date. We will continuously update its construction status.

April 23 - Richard Stuart in many instances had been generous in helping us moved the 40' container. On this date, we have to move the container to its present location.

April 25 - Laying of underground sewer pipe started

April 26 - Delivery of portable trailer

April 27 - Members of the Knights of Columbus Council, Bob Green, Ed Pagala and Matthew Longo used their combined efforts to pull forward 93,000 pounds of weight (restroom trailer).

April 29 - Laying of piers, pads and anchors completed

Members of Tongan community and some of our parishioners have volunteered to initially renovate the trailer to be used as restrooms. We need more volunteers to help us. Any form of manual help is appreciated. Sign-up sheet is available in the narthex.

We are still in need of your financial help. We have raised **\$14,008 since January** of this year. We have spent \$12,000 for the portable trailer, and \$4,500.00 for the laying of the underground sewer pipe. **We need at least \$7,000 more** to complete the project.
