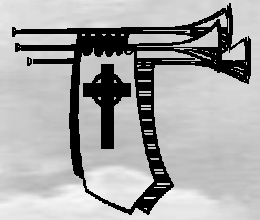

Message from Our Pastor . . .

The Feast of the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ into Heaven



Our Lord Jesus Christ after His passion, death and resurrection, He ascended into heaven as the Acts of the Apostle tells us in today's first reading. "He presented Himself alive to them by many proofs after He had suffered, appearing to them during **forty days** and speaking about the kingdom of God" (Acts 1: 3).

The sermon of St. Augustine on the Feast of The Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ into heaven is very enlightening and is worth reflecting on it to assist us along the journey. It is true that *"our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven so let our hearts ascend with Him. Listen to the words of St. Paul: "If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth (Colossians 3: 1-2). For just as Jesus remained with us even after His ascension, so we too are already in heaven with Him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies. Christ is now exalted above the heavens, but He still suffers on earth all the pain that we, the members of His body, have to bear. He showed this when he cried out from above: Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? And when He said: "I was hungry and you gave me food."*

Why do we on earth not strive to find rest with Him in heaven even now, through the faith, hope and love that unite us to Him? While in heaven He is also with us; and we, while on earth are with Him. He is here with us by His divinity, His power and His love. We cannot be in heaven, as He is on earth, by divinity, but in Him, we can be there by love.

He did not leave heaven when He came down to us; nor did He withdraw from us when He went up again into heaven. The fact that He was in heaven even while He was on earth is born out by His own statement: No one has ever ascended into heaven except the Son of Man who descended from heaven.

These words are explained by our oneness with Christ, for He is our head and we are His body. No one ascended into heaven except Christ because we also are Christ: He is the Son of Man by His union with us, and we by our union with Him are the children of God. So the Apostle says: Just as the human body, which has many members, is a unity, because all the different members make one body, so is it also with Christ. He too has many members, but one body.

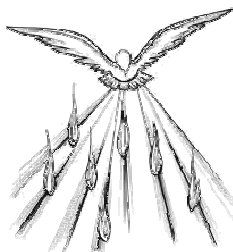
Out of compassion for us He descended from heaven, and although He ascended alone, we also ascend, because we are in Him by grace. Thus, no one but Christ descended and no one but Christ ascended; not because there is no distinction between the head and the body, but because the body as a unity cannot be separated from the head.

Today is also Mother's Day which is very special to us all in Divine Mercy. **I wish you "All Mothers" a special blessing from our Savior Jesus Christ on the Feast of His Ascension into Heaven.** Let us also pray that all those who have lost their mothers will be consoled by the Lord. Have a Great Feast Day!

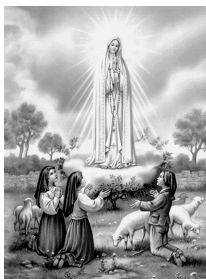
