Message from Deacon Rick Morales . . .



From the words of Jesus on the Cross on Good Friday "It is finished" we have now come to this day of Pentecost, the sending of the Advocate, the One that Jesus said that it was good that He go so we could possess.

The Church was born from the side of Christ on Good Friday shortly after Jesus declared that His work was finished and gave up His Spirit. It was publicly announced to all the nations in their own individual languages on this feast of Pentecost.

The depth of the love that God shows us in the passion, death and resurrection of His Son and the birth of the Church that He left us on earth is unfathomable. It is so deep that a lifetime of contemplation would scarcely begin to plumb its depths. Perhaps we just rejoice in the gift that Christ won for us and make our own the beautiful words of the Sequence, Veni, Sancte, Spiritus (Come, O Holy Spirit, Come), that is sung at the Mass during the Day for this Pentecost Sunday.
